Discussion Guide “Source of Truth” Pastor Daniel Floyd

Starter What’s the funniest or most random thing social media has ever convinced you to try, buy, or believe?

Sermon Summary

In a world filled with competing voices and constantly changing ideas, where we look for truth will shape the direction of our lives. This message explores why God’s Word is the reliable foundation for knowing Jesus, experiencing true freedom, and building a faith that remains steady no matter what comes.

ACT

As you absorb sermons, read, or participate in group discussion, take notes and make a plan to apply what God’s teaching you.

A (Action): Mark important ideas with an “A” to remind you to take action.

C (Contemplate): Use a “C” to mark ideas you want to process further.

T (Transfer/Teach): If it’s something you need to teach to someone else, note it with a “T.”

Discuss

Choose questions to keep the discussion moving. There’s no need to discuss every question.

1. What are some of the voices or influences that most shape how people think about truth today?
2. Why do you think people often find it difficult to accept truth when it conflicts with their feelings or personal preferences?
3. What does it practically look like to build your life on God’s Word instead of cultural trends?

4. How has spending time in Scripture changed the way you think about God or make decisions?
5. Jesus said that truth sets us free. Where have you experienced freedom through following Christ, or where are you still trusting Him for freedom?

Go Deeper

1. Study [Joshua 1:1–9](#) (meditating on God’s Word). How does consistently meditating on Scripture strengthen your confidence when facing uncertainty?
2. Study [Psalm 119:97–105](#) (wisdom, guidance, light). What are some practical ways Scripture has illuminated a difficult decision or season in your life?
3. Study [Acts 17:10–12](#) (examining Scripture daily). What can we learn from the Bereans about testing ideas and teachings against God’s Word?
4. Study [Colossians 2:6–8](#) (remaining rooted in Christ). What philosophies or messages today compete with a Christ-centered worldview?

Apply

1. Spend time reading a portion of Scripture each day this week, asking God to reveal His truth rather than simply seeking information.
2. Identify one belief or perspective you’ve adopted from culture and compare it honestly with what God’s Word teaches.
3. Before making an important decision this week, intentionally seek biblical wisdom through prayer and Scripture.
4. Memorize [John 14:6](#) or [John 8:32](#) and reflect on how Jesus defines truth and freedom.

Pray

Here are some prayer points:

1. Pray for a deeper hunger to know God through His Word.
2. Ask God for discernment to recognize truth amid competing voices and influences.
3. Pray for the courage to obey God’s truth even when it’s unpopular or uncomfortable.
4. Thank Jesus for being the source of truth and ask Him to continue bringing freedom into every area of your life.

Leadership Tip

Encourage your group members to explore the Scriptures together rather than simply sharing opinions. When differing perspectives arise, gently guide the conversation back to what God’s Word says, helping the group grow in both biblical understanding and Christlike love.
